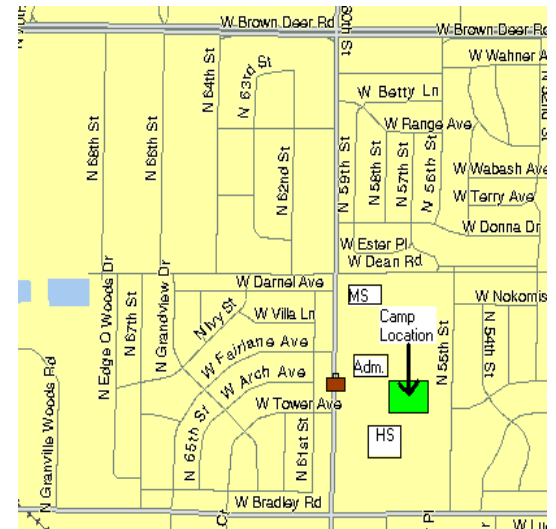
## **Camp Information**
